Suggested topics include, but are not limited to the following:

- Greene’s depiction of women
- The short fiction
- The early novels
- The plays
- Greene’s travels on ‘the dangerous edge of things’
- Book and film reviews and other feature articles will also be considered.

All submissions must be original, unpublished work. Papers should be between 2,500 and 10,000 words. Citations must follow *The Chicago Manual of Style*, 16th edition documentation guidelines. All papers should be submitted double-spaced in Word document format. Readers and Graham Greene International Festival goers are encouraged to submit.
