I have been unable to see
Fred. since I left your letter at his
Office until yesterday, and delayed
writing you in expectation of hearing
something to the purpose from him.

time to give you all you wanted, or
rather asked for. His wife is quite sick
and he has very little time on his hands
at present. She probably is or will soon be
in Consumption; her mother, brother and
sister all died of it.
