Forty-five faculty, staff and administrators participated in the College's Strategic Planning workshop on May 17. Dr. Tom Walter facilitated the identification and discussion of important issues the institution should address. The participation reflected broad various perspectives and concerns, but there was general agreement on the following issues:

- Clearly define our mission and image and communicate internally and externally;
- 2.) Enhance our student's freshman year experience;
- 3.) Evaluate academic standards at the division level;
- 4.) Balance our high technology and soft touch; and
- 5.) Provide expanded student support services

All of these need to be addressed within an environment of planned growth.

These issues fit in the broader College Strategic Plan. If they are not clearly identified under one of the goals, they will be added. These issues will also be the focus of our 2006-07 Institutional Goals. The revised drafts of the Strategic Plan and 2006-07 Institutional Goals will be communicated to the college community by June 16.

Students must complete the HOPE authorization form in Banner Web in order to receive the book check.


