FROM THE GUIDANCE CENTER

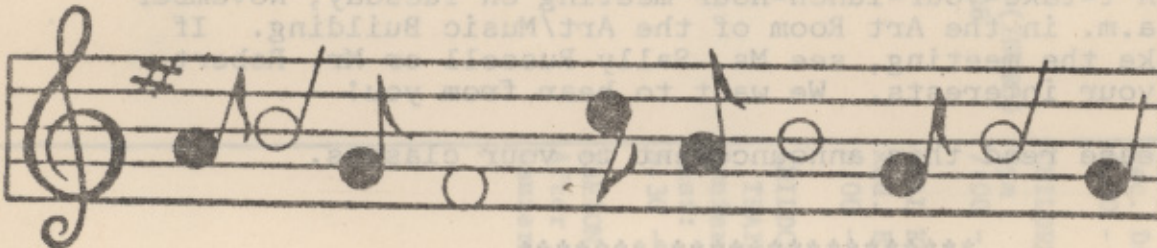
